I'd wanted to connect with a greater body of believers for 5-Day club for a while now, and my prayers were answered when OneLife obliged to host the club. As a result of the club, a boy named Soren accepted Jesus into his heart on Monday.

All in all, this was an incredible summer. It was a challenging summer for me personally, as I made the transition from CYIA teacher to team trainer, which I found very difficult to find my place as an authority figure and mentor over teachers that I've seen as friends for such a long time. Although I had a very different role and relationship with my team this year, I was able to uplift and help some teachers in ways that I wouldn't have been able to if I were in the same boat. For that, I praise God. The Lord also showed his goodness to us in the form of salvations, bringing so many to a relationship with him.
