## **Getting Ready for CYIA State Training**



There are quite a few steps in getting ready to be Summer Missionaries in Christian Youth in Action. As you saw in the last newsletter, the first step was CYIA Pre-Training at Camp Morrow. Then the decision if you are going to give of yourself and a few weeks of your summer to serve the Lord by sharing the gospel with children. But there is also a cost to go to State CYIA Training at Aldersgate Campground in Turner, Oregon. The cost per student which includes their summer 5-Day Club kit is \$225. At CYIA Pre-Training we gave the teens ideas on how they could earn money for their training. The teens from Condon had a Spaghetti dinner on Mother's Day to raise the money for their training. eron Whatley. What a great thing to receive support from your church family and make a way for Mothers to have dinner prepared for them. We have other teens earning money by pulling weeds for people here in The Dalles. We've had some work done outside of the CEF office to help in the cost of State Training also. I will be working with another CYIA teen next weekend in clearing tree branches here at the office to help her earn some money. All the teens are expected to buy their five CYIA shirts they will be wearing at the summer 5-Day Clubs. The cost of those shirts are \$25, but for those who have completed their lesson devotions and turned them in will have them paid for by Mid-Columbia Chapter. I also know many of these CYIA teens either share before or after their summer with their churches and supporters what God is doing in their lives.


