### SEE YOU AT THE POLE

September 25th was the "See You At The Pole" event at our schools. See You at the Pole (SYATP) is the global day of student prayer, that began in 1990. Decades later, millions pray on their campuses on the fourth Wednesday in September. It is simply a prayer rally where students meet at the school flagpole before school to lift up their friends, families, teachers, school, and nation to God. It is a student-initiated, student-organized, and student-led event.

I had the privilege of being invited to the school of my two daughters to lead the flag raising and share a moment before prayer of the value of our flag. There I shared Psalm 33:12a "Blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord…" As I then listened to the kids lead out in prayer, there was a pattern of concern over the future of our nation. Prayers like "Lord, please push back the darkness that is being brought to our schools." I thought of a teacher whom I know, who is a Christian . I thought of how she described the things she was being asked to teach and the policies the district has. I know a recently retired principle, who retired, in part, because of those same concerns.

What would bring concern, frustration or fear into the heart of an educator or two, let alone children? According to the Bible, we live in a dark world. Ephesians 6:12 says "For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms."

We all have our attention on what is happening in our nation, and we need to do our part to participate in our world to influence it for Christ. Lets be sure to invade the darkness and do so carrying the light of Jesus. Bringing His love for all people, Jesus came with the purpose of helping the lost. And that is our task as well.
