Teaching Children Effectively

One of the things that I have found in ministering to children over the last 25 years is that there is a right way to lead a child to Christ and a wrong way. The very best training I have ever seen in leading a child to Christ is the TCE courses that CEF provides.

Julie Fritts led a TCE Level 1 course this month at Rowena Baptist Church, for the community of Mid-Columbia. She was assisted by Colette Kuhl and Jolene Morse. They taught the course material and conducted the practicum evaluations for 13 students in attendance over three weekends in October.

You may ask "what is TCE?" *Teaching Children Effectively* (*TCE*TM) Level 1 is designed to offer a fresh approach to evangelizing and teaching children. Based on spiritual and educational principles, the course provides the methods and procedures to lead children to Christ and immediately equips the believer to begin and sustain a ministry where he lives. Student practicums are a vital part of the instructional procedure which makes *TCE* a refreshing way to train Christians in child evangelism. TCE Level 1 students can earn five Continuing Education Units (CEUs) in professional education or in Bible for completing this course.

I wish that everyone would take this course. It is profound as well as fun. The comradery among the students will leave you with new friends as well as support to complete the course together. If you are involved in children's ministries in any way, I highly recommend taking this course; you will not regret it.




